Taxpayers who are eligible to claim the child tax credit, the earned income credit and the American Opportunity college credit or file as head of household will be required to provide additional documentation to support the due diligence required by the IRS.

Other Items of Note:

- Records of Purchase, Sale or Refinance of a House (Closing Disclosure/Settlement Package)
- Medical and Dental Expenses (**SUMMARIZED ONLY - DO NOT PROVIDE MEDICAL RECEIPTS**)
- Real Estate and Personal Property Taxes (if not on mortgage statement)
- Estimated Tax Payments - List of payments by date & amount & if Federal or State
- Cash and Non-Cash Charitable Donations
- Childcare Expenses and Provider Information (Provider Info, ID#, Phone #, Total \$ Paid for Year **PER CHILD**)
- Alimony - Amount Paid or Amount Received + Date of Divorce Decree
- Unreimbursed Employment Related Expenses (**PA ONLY**)
